

## Beccie Scarf

### SIZE

OS

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 62 inches long, 10 inches wide (after blocking)

### MATERIALS

Berrocco Foliage [53% New Wool, 47% Acrylic; 100yd/92m per 50g skein]; Color 5985; 2 skeins

1 set US #13 needles

notions required:

scissors

measuring tape

### GAUGE (approximate...not needed for scarf)

12 sts/17 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

### PATTERN

Using the long tail method, CO 20.

Work in garter stitch for 3 rows, slip one stitch at the beginning of each row.

Pattern 1:

Row 1: S1, K2, \*YO, K2T\* repeat 7 times, K3.

Row 2: S1, Knit

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until piece measures 9 inches.

Begin Pattern 2:

Row 1: S1, Knit

Row 2: S1, K2, P14, K3

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until piece measures 49 inches.

Begin Pattern 1:

Repeat rows 1 and 2 of pattern 1 until piece measures 58"

Work in garter stitch for 3 rows.

Cast off.

### FINISHING

Weave in all ends. Soak piece in cold water for 20 minutes. Gently squeeze out excess water and block scarf to 62 inches long and 10 inches wide. Let dry.



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
