



Kuick Katrina Kotton Kloth (aka K-4) by Cheryl Kemp

US #13 Needles
Sugar n Cream Cotton Yarn:
1 skein Yellow
1 skein Violet Veil Ombre

MK=purl 3, pass 2nd and 3rd stitch over 1st
MS= k1, P1, k1 all into next stitch
S1=slip

This cloth can be knitted very quickly due to the needle size and doubling of the yarn. The color pattern is created by the variegated yarn

while the texture comes from bobbles interspersed through the cloth. Carry the two yarns together throughout.

CO 25 using the long tail cast on (this will count as the first knit row)

Row 1: S1, knit across
Row 2: S1, P1 MS, P1, * P2, MS P1* repeat until last stitch, K1
Row 3: S1, *MK, K2* repeat to last 6 stitches, K1, MK, K2
Row 4: S1, purl across
Row 5: S1, knit across
Row 6: S1, P3, *MS, P3* repeat until last stitch, K1
Row 7: S1 *K3, MK* repeat to last 4 stitches, K4.
Row 8: S1, purl across

Repeat 1-8 until desired length is reached.
