This scarf was designed for my nieces Lauren and Amy.

SIZE

OS

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 65" to 80" long and 4" wide (after blocking)

MATERIALS

Reynolds Andean Alpaca Regal [90% Alpaca, 10% Wool/110y per 100g skein];

Color 70: 1.5 skeins

Or

South West tTrading Company Gianna [50% Soysilk, 50% Wool/42.5m per 50g skein]; Color 043: 3 skeins

Or

Bulky weight yarn with similar gauge

1 set US #11 needles

notions required:

scissors

measuring tape

GAUGE (approximate...not needed for scarf)

16 sts = 4" in stockinette stitch

C8F: Slip 4 sts to a cable needle and hold to front, k4 then k4 from cable needle

PATTERN

Border--

Row 1 : k1, p1 across

Row 2: p1, k1 across

Repeat rows 1 and 2 once more

Setup--

Row 1 k2, p2, k8, p2, k2

Row 2 k4, p8, k4

Repeat rows 1 and 2 once more

Pattern--

Row 1: K2, p2, c8f, p2, k2

Row 2: K4, p8, k4





Row 3: K2, p2, k8, p2, k2
Row 4: k4, p8, k4
Rows 5-8: Repeat rows 3 & 4

Repeat pattern rows 1-8 until scarf measures 50" long or desired length. Repeat Setup section and bind off loosely

FINISHING

Weave in all ends. Soak piece in cold water for 20 minutes. Gently squeeze out excess water and block scarf to 65 inches long and 4 inches wide or desired dimensions. Pin to shape and let dry.
